This notice is issued in accordance with Articles 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 ("GDPR"), with reference to the processing of video recordings acquired by the video surveillance system at the headquarters of Fondazione Links – Leading Innovation & Knowledge for Society based in via Pier Carlo Boggio 61, 10138 Torino.

Purposes of the Processing

The aforementioned personal data/images are collected, recorded, stored and used for purposes of security, verification and control of access and transit in areas subject to control and protection of corporate assets.

Video recordings may also be used to carry out findings, checks and verifications for defensive purposes in the event that situations or conduct detrimental to the company's security and assets, as well as illegal facts, are revealed.

In addition, at the request of the competent authorities, it may be transmitted to them as part of investigations and for the investigation of possible injuries.

Legal Basis

The recorded data are processed for legitimate interests of the Data Controller and third parties (art. 6 par. 1 lett. f) represented by the security and protection of property assets and prevention of unlawful conduct (theft, damage, tampering) as well as for possible investigation of injuries, in full respect of the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subjects in a context of balancing interests.

The legal basis legitimizing the communication of images to the P.S. or P.G. authorities is the fulfilment of a legal obligation to which the Data Controller is subject (Art. 6 par. 1 lett.c).

Data processing modes

The system parameters, hours of operation, camera areas, angles, focal lengths and depths of filming have been configured in such a way that the processing of images is carried out with respect for the fundamental rights and freedoms, as well as the dignity of all physical persons passing through and accessing the camera area.

Data Recipients

The processed personal data is not disseminated, *i.e.*, no information is disclosed to unspecified parties.

Access to the facility and video recordings is allowed only to authorized personnel.

Access to the data may be allowed to external parties who, for purposes related to the security of the plant, must perform services or support and maintenance services on our behalf.

Finally, they may be made available to judicial authorities, police forces or other parties entitled to access them by virtue of legal provisions, regulations, European standards.

Data Retention

The Data Controller retains and processes personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the stated purposes. In the present case, data are retained for 72 hours after registration and then overwritten, unless longer retention times are provided for damage assessment of the alleged wrongdoing.

Rights of Data Subjects

Data subjects have the right to exercise the rights provided by the GDPR, articles 15 ff. Specifically, they may request:

- the right of access, in order to know how your data is processed; the response to an access request may not include any data referring to third parties, unless the breakdown of the video recordings or the deprivation of certain elements makes the third parties filmed unidentifiable. Once the above retention periods have elapsed, it will be impossible to comply with the access request, as no data is processed anymore;



- the right to erasure of personal data concerning you within the terms provided before the overwriting, unless there is an interest of the Data Controller or third parties that legitimizes their retention;
- the right to restrict processing under the conditions provided for in Art. 18;
- the right to object in the forms and ways provided for in Art. 21 GDPR.
- the right to lodge a complaint with the Authority (Data Protection Authority).

The right to update or supplement, as well as the right to rectification referred to in Article 16 of the GDPR cannot be exercised in practice in view of the nature of the processing resulting from the video surveillance system in use (images collected in real time concerning a realistic fact).

Likewise, the right to data portability under Article 20 of the GDPR cannot be exercised because the images captured by the video surveillance system cannot be transferred to other parties.

To exercise the rights, write to the above addresses, specifying the right you wish to exercise and providing elements useful for the correct identification of the data subject attesting to the legitimacy of the request.
